Forum Sessions:

- * Brothers in Arms- We will hear from a panel of our Vietnamese Allies who served alongside American troops in Vietnam.
- * The War At Home and Transition to America: In this panel we will hear from the wives of our Allies and the struggles they faced during and post War in Vietnam and in America. In addition, we are fortunate enough to hear from our 2016 Scholarship Winner as a second-generation Vietnamese-American.
- *Cultural Roundtable: In this session we will experience Vietnamese Culture. (fashion show, Vietnamese wedding traditions, food, arts, music, and dance)
- *Classroom Connections- In the afternoon portion of the program we will discuss how you can bring this information into the classroom with three breakout sessions on Memorial and Art, Memoirs as Primary Sources, and Parallels between the Current Crisis in Syria.
