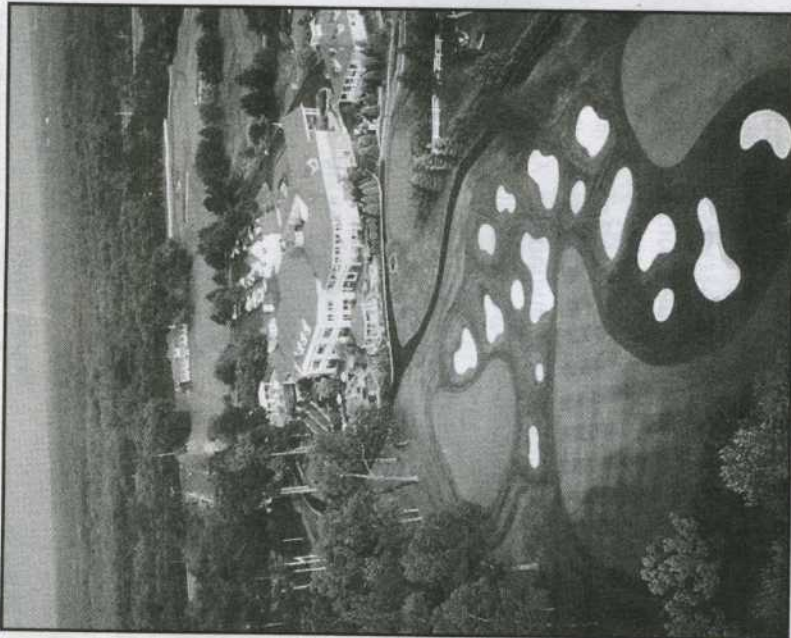

## Frank Pallone Announces Senate Bid, Declares, 'I'm In!'

At June 10, 2013 press conference in Trenton, NJ, Congressman Frank Pallone, Jr. (NJ-06) announced his candidacy to fill the remaining term of the late Senator Frank R. Lautenberg.

Immediately prior to hand-delivering nominating petitions signed by supporters to New Jersey's Division of Elections, Pallone told a crowd of gathered reporters of his intention to run for the open Senate seat.

"Today, I am proud to stand here and declare my candidacy to be the next U.S. Senator from the great state of New Jersey," said Pallone. "Although I wish this opportunity to run for the seat vacated as a result of the loss of my good friend and colleague, Senator Frank Lautenberg, had never risen, I am committed to carrying on his legacy of fighting for New Jersey."

Pallone, a 13 term Congressman from Long Branch spoke of his long record of advocating for all New Jerseyans and laid out some of his top priorities.

"I'm in," said Pallone. "I'm in this race because families in our state and throughout the nation are hurting, and I believe that we have a responsibility to roll up our sleeves, get to work and help. Throughout my career, I have been committed to public service and to the idea that, no matter the size of the challenge, I would continue to stand and fight and work toward sensible solutions."

A progressive Democrat with a long record of achieving results for New Jersey, Pallone cited his core Democratic principles and belief that government can be a tool for good as influencing his decision to run for the Senate.

"I'm running for the Senate because we need to focus on getting people back to work, rebuilding our economy, making sure our environment is clean and safe for future generations, and standing up for equality for all Americans," said Pallone.

Late Ed Eget

During the Tournament's Dinner and Award Ceremony at 6:00 p.m., the New Jersey Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Foundation is proud to honor the late Ed Eget by presenting the Edward Eget Memorial Trophy to the foursome or team with the lowest score, using the Calloway method.

Eget served in Vietnam as a helicopter pilot and was seriously wounded in action in June of 1969. His combat awards include the Air Medal with 16 clusters, the Bronze Star and the Purple Heart.

Prior to Vietnam, Eget also received the highest non-combat related medal that can be awarded for valor, the Airman's Medal, for pulling passengers and crew from a burning airplane in Bermuda.

Other prizes awarded include Team Prizes, Closest to Pin and Longest Drive.

"We are proud and humbled by the sacrifices, courage and valor of the Vietnam veterans," said Peter Cancro, founder and CEO Jersey Mike's Subs. "It's our honor to continue supporting the New Jersey Vietnam Veterans' Memorial Foundation."

### 2013/2014 FINAL TAX BILL INFORMATION

Tax bills will be mailed out mid to end of July. The grace period for payment will be extended to a minimum of 25 days after the mailing date. The last day to pay before interest accrues will be noted on the memo section of the bill and on the bottom of the 3rd quarter stub.

### Homestead Credit Update

Homeowners that were eligible for the 2011 NJ Homestead Benefit will see a credit reflected on the 3rd quarter tax stub.
